Sub: Faculty Claims to CHSS

In the recent Executive Committee (EC) Meeting of Faculty Association (FA) held on May 30, 2013, it has been decided to call for special general body meeting (GBM) of faculties to discuss the developments in the reforms of current health scheme adopted by the institute (CHSS). Before this GBM is fixed, the EC felt that it is necessary to obtain the following information for this special GBM.

- 1). How much is the total deductions for the current CHSS?. What percentage is Faculties (including Technical officers, Scientific Officers (senior/principal/chief), Assistant/Associate Professors, and Professors) Contribution?
- 2). Out of the total insurance claims, please give split up of following claims for faculty (including Technical officers, Scientific Officers (senior/principal/chief), Assistant/Associate Professors, and Professors) and non-faculty cadres for the period: 01/08/2012 to 31/05/2013
  - (a). No. of claims up to Rs.50,000
  - (b). No. of claims from Rs. 50,001- 1 lakh
  - (c). No of claims above Rs. 1 lakh
- 3). Please give the split-up of number of claims that have utilized the buffer amount in CHSS in the faculty (including Technical officers, Scientific Officers (senior/principal/chief), Assistant/Associate Professors, and Professors) and non-faculty cadres for the period: 01/08/2012 to 31/05/2013
